Beverly and Qamanirjuaq are a huge deal for Inuit. Inuit love caribou meat. When Caribou are passing by after a while, we have to leave the first group in order to get to their migration grounds and being disturb, they will get a new route.

Barrenground Caribou are a medium size Cervids that can adapt to a life spent in the cold. On mainland of Nunavut, Adult males weigh an average of 150kg in Fall, Adult Females weigh average is about 90kgs. Caribou feed on grasses, sedges, forbs, willow leaves, twigs and mushrooms. Caribou lives on Barren land or tundra of Northern Canada. They travel in herds of 10 - 50 animals, or loose bands of thousands on mainland.

They always move from one season to another, travelling as far as 1200km.

It is dangerous to shoot, ^{around} people near the caribou or people down the hill.

We should be able to use the whole caribou if we're going to harvest one. Shooting caribou close by is great. But if you think it is sick or has a disease you should probably get it checked.

Brucellosis is a naturally disease caused by bacteria, it is found in Caribou and reindeer most arctic regions of the world, including Nunavut.
