BQCMB On the Land Program



The BQCMB On the Land Program provides funding to help support community programs that expose school-aged youth in Beverly and Qamanirjuaq caribou range communities to hunting, trapping and land skills, passed on from experienced hunters, trappers and elders.

Upon approval of the BQCMB, classroom projects including interviews with hunters, elders, and biologists may be combined with projects on the land.

The BQCMB provides \$10,000 per fiscal year (April 1^{st} – March 31^{st}) to this program. The number and amount of grants awarded each year is determined by the number of applicants.

Each Applicant agrees to:

- 1. Organize a caribou hunt or similar on the land project and provide demonstrations involving youth
- 2. Ensure conservation examples and teaching are provided and practised
- 3. Ensure safety practices are taught, demonstrated and followed for matters such as winter survival, gun safety, boating safety, vehicle operation and basic first aid practices
- 4. Provide high resolution photos of the Project for use by the Beverly and Qamanirjuaq Caribou Management Board
- 5. Provide a brief report describing activities and spending by April 15th of the following year for presentation at the spring BQCMB meeting.

The BQCMB provides funds in two instalments:

- 1. Half (50%) upon signing of a Letter of Agreement.
- 2. Remainder after commitments outlined above are fulfilled.

If the Project is not conducted, the Applicant must return the funding to the Beverly and Qamanirjuaq Caribou Management Board or make alternate arrangements suitable to the Board.
