Background:

Since 1988, the Beverly and Qamanirjuaq Caribou Management Board (BQCMB) has helped post-secondary students learn more about the management and conservation of barren-ground caribou and their habitat through the Caribou Research and Management Award, sponsored by the Caribou Management Scholarship Fund. The annual award, administered by the Association of Canadian Universities for Northern Studies (ACUNS), currently carries a value of up to \$1,500 and is open to anyone studying barren-ground caribou and/or their range in Canada. Preference is given to applicants from a caribou-range community and to those examining the Beverly and Qamanirjuaq herds or seeking a career in natural resource management. Award amounts may vary from year to year depending on the prevailing interest rates.

In 2016, the BQCMB re-named the Caribou Research and Management Award the Gunther Abrahamson Research and Management Award, in honour of the BQCMB's first secretary-treasurer, the late Gunther Abrahamson.
