Caribou harvesters can reduce wastage and show respect for caribou and the land by:



Respecting your neighbour's traditional hunting lands.



Sighting in your rifle and taking careful shots.



Shooting bulls instead of cows, when possible, during periods when caribou herds are declining or small.



Recovering your kill and all wounded animals.



Handling and **storing** caribou meat and parts carefully.



Leaving the land and waters clean and tidy.



Making use of ALL parts of caribou.



Take only what you need, use all that you take,
and leave only your footprints behind.
