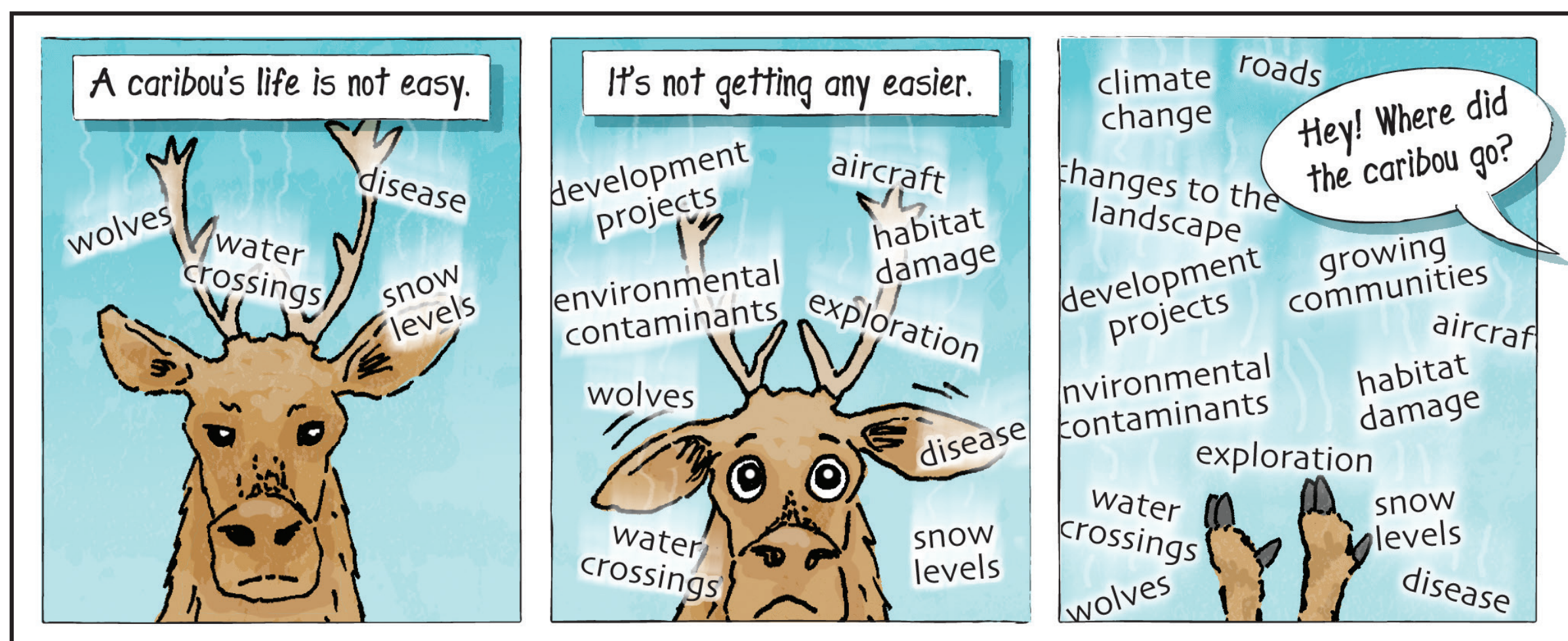


# Cumulative Effects

Natural and human-caused effects on caribou and habitat add up over time, and their combined effects can cause problems for the herds. We can reduce the cumulative effects that harm the land and wildlife, and the people who depend on them, if:

- ❖ **Companies** working on the caribou range make it a priority to avoid harming caribou and caribou habitat.
- ❖ **Decision-makers** reject projects that will cause harmful effects on caribou or habitat.
- ❖ **Regulators** place conditions on projects to minimize negative impacts on caribou and caribou range and **make sure conditions are enforced**.
- ❖ **Harvesters** follow responsible caribou hunting practices.



We all need to work together to reduce cumulative effects on caribou and their habitat.
